General provisions

Organisation: OC University/City of Ghent

Attendance: Presentation of players is required the latest 30 minutes before the start of the

competition.

Awards: The first 3 places from each category will receive medals and diplomas.

Technical provisions

Rules: The competition is in accordance with the regulations of the International

Badminton Federation and the regulations mentioned in this document and

the briefing letter for each category.

Requierements: The organisation will provide official approved feather shuttlecocks.

Conditions of participation: Properly registered teams in the term, including payment of invoices.

Class divisions:

Mix "Open Class" for all ages

A team consists of 3 players (max. 6 players).

The teams contains 1 woman and 2 men – (max. 2 women and 4 men). The team composition can be changed before starting a new match.

Mix "Senior Class" for 40 years old and over (40+)

A team consists of 4 players (max. 8 players).

The teams contains 2 women and 2 men – (max. 4 women and 4 men). The team composition can be changed before starting a new match.

Game model:

Mix "Open Class" for all ages

Each match has 4 individual games in the following order: Mixed double / Men's single / Women's single / Men's double

Mix "Senior Class" for 40 years old and over (40+)

Each match has 4 individual games in the following order:

1st Mixed double / 2nd Mixed double / Men's double / Women's double

System of play: Games are played up to best of 3 sets.

Each set is played up to 21 points. At 20-all the two point rule will for time

reasons NOT be applied.

Results: Criteria for the order in a pool: 1. Wins, 2. Games, 3. Sets, 4. Points, 5.

individual match, 6. a draw.

Criteria for the order in a knock-out: 1. Win. Results will be be published in the Meeting Center.

Referees: Matches don't have referees. The players themselves judge the individual

games and are responsible for keeping their score.

Objections: Teams can submit a protest against the game or decision in 30 minutes after

the game and are obligated for a deposit of 20 EUR, which in case of compliance of your objection will be returned. Potential protest will be

addressed to organisers and ECSG sport manager.

Special arrangements: Each participant travels and attends at his own risk. Organiser provides first

aid only. It is recommended to carry your insurance card with you at all time.

The organiser reserves the right to modify or change the schedule if

necessary.
