

SCHEDULE PETANQUE

European Company Sport Games 2017

General provisions

- Organisation:** KPC Schorpioen
- Location:** KPC Schorpioen – Botestraat 98A, 9032 Wondelgem
- Date:** 22.06.2017 – 23.06.2017 – 24.06.2017
- Attendance:** Presentation of players is required the latest 30 minutes before the start of their first game.
- Awards:** The 3 best teams of each discipline will receive medals and diplomas.

Technical provisions

- Rules:** The competition is in accordance with the regulations of International Petanque Federation and the regulations mentioned in this document.
- Conditions of participation:** Properly registered teams in the term, including payment of invoices.
- Class division:** No division into gender or age classes.
- Game model:**
- Doubles: 2 players play against 2 players. Each player uses three boules.
 - Triples: 3 players play against 3 players. Each player uses two boules.
- System:**
- The game is generally played up to 13 points, (50 minutes max + 1 game)
- The double/triple which has won the most games is the winner.
- The double/triple is ranked in each game on points, so that the double/triple with most points is n°1 and the next best team is n°2 etc.
- If 2 teams are tied, the games they have played together decide the result.
 - If the teams are still tied, the team with the biggest difference between games won and games lost and then the biggest score, is the winner.
- The summarization of placement after 4 rounds and the following advance will be according these criteria:
1. Number of wins
 2. Higher number of positive points in score
 3. Score differences

- Time limit:** All matches are played on time limit. Time limit will start at one time and will be signaled by audio signal. End of limit will be also signaled by audio signal. If an audio signal sounds during played game, that game will be finished and then starts a new game. Moment of throwing the last ball of the game means moment of start the new game. It's strict to respect the maximum limit of one minute to throw a ball.
- Results:** Results will be hang out on the sports venue. Also each evening all results will be published in the Meeting Center.
- Objections:** Teams can submit a protest against the game or decision in 30 minutes after the game and are obligated for a deposit of 20 EUR, which in case of compliance of your objection will be returned. Potential protest will be addressed to organisers and ECSG sport manager.
- Special arrangements:** Each participant travels and attends at his own risk. Organiser provides first aid only. It is recommended to carry your insurance card with you at all time.
- The organiser reserves the right to modify or change the schedule if necessary.

Time schedule:

8.15 – 9u15: the presentation and registration of teams

9.30: Start 1st games

18.00: Expected end

Each team will play 4 matches per day and, if possible with time, the best 16 teams advance to a fifth knock out round.

The 8 winning teams will play the semi finals and finals on saturday.

All matches are played to 13 points with 50 minutes time limit + 1 game.

Friday 23.06.2017 – Tournament of Triples

8.15 – 9.15: the presentation and registration of teams

9.30: Start 1st games

18.00: Expected end

Each team will play 4 matches per day and, if possible with time, the best 16 teams advance to a fifth knock out round.

The 8 winning teams will play the semi finals and finals on saturday .

All matches are played to 13 points with 50 minutes time limit + 1 game.

11:15 Semi final triples (60min +1 game)

13:00 Final doubles (60min+1 game) + match of 3.place at same time

14:30 Final triples (60min+1 game) + match of 3.place at same time
