

SCHEDULE SQUASH

European Company Sport Games 2017

General provisions

- Organisation:** Bateas
- Locations:** Sports facility Bateas – Dendermondsesteenweg 397, 9040 Gent
Sports facility Blaarmeersen - Campinglaan 13, 9000 Gent
- Date:** 22.06.2017 – 24.06.2017
- Attendance:** Presentation of players is required the latest 30 minutes before the start of their first game.
- Awards:** The 3 best teams for each category will receive medals and diplomas.

Technical provisions

- Rules:** The competition is in accordance with the regulations of the World Squash Federation (WSF) and the regulations mentioned in this document.
- Requirements:** Rackets and balls must be approved and meet WSF specifications. Players bring their own rackets.
- Conditions of participation:** Properly registered teams in the term, including payment of invoices.

Class divisions:

- Men "Open Class" for all ages.
- Men "Senior Class" for 40 years and over (40+)
- Mix "Open Class" for all ages
- Mix "Senior Class" for 40 years and over (40+)

Women "Open Class" for all ages and "Senior Class" for 40 years and over (40+) was canceled.

- Game model:** A team consists of 3 players (max. 6 players).
A mixed team consists of 1 woman and 2 men, max. 2 women and 4 men.
The team composition can be changed before starting a new match.

Each team match has 3 individual games in the following order:

MEN	WOMEN	MIX
Men's single 1	Women's single 1	Women's single
Men's single 2	Women's single 2	Men's single 1
Men's single 3	Women's single 3	Men's single 2

The team that wins two matches is the winning team. However, all matches are played till the end, even with a score of 2:0.

Scoring system:

Point-a-rally scoring (PARS) to 11 will be used.

A match will be played to best of 3 games, during finals up to 3 winning games.

The winning team gets 3 points; the losing team gets 0 points.

The teams are ranked in each pool on points, so that the team with most points is n°1 and the next-best team is n°2 etc.

Criteria for the order in a group:

1. points
2. mutual match
3. the difference in the scores among sets
4. higher number of won sets
5. the difference in the scores among balls
6. higher number of won balls
7. a draw In case of equality of more than 2 teams a table of mutual matches will be prepared and final results will be according these criteria (above).

For Lucky Losers there are the same criteria without the mutual match.

Referees:

Games can be played without a referee. The players themselves judge the individual games. Except on Saturday there will be a referee for the semifinals and finals.

Results:

Results will be hang out on the sports venue. Also each evening all results will be published in the Meeting Center.

Objections:

Teams can submit a protest against the game or decision in 30 minutes after the game and are obligated for a deposit of 20 EUR, which in case of compliance of your objection will be returned. Potential protest will be addressed to organisers and ECSG sport manager.

Special arrangements: Each participant travels and attends at his own risk. Organiser provides first aid only. It is recommended to carry your insurance card with you at all time.

The organiser reserves the right to modify or change the schedule if necessary.

Presentation of all teams according the time schedule is required! If a team is not present on time, it lose by forfeit 3:0 with no exceptions.
